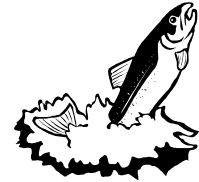

GENERAL RULES

- Both owners and riders must be NRCHA & MVRCHA members.
- A copy of your horse's registration papers must be on file or accompany your entry form.
- All NRCHA Rules Apply. Owner and Rider must sign waiver below prior to competing.
- Checks will not be issued without a Social Security # or Tax ID #.
- Hackamore Classes will be drawn after the Derby Fence Work.
- Late entries will be drawn up last in the cutting, first in the dry and fence work according to NRCHA rules. Horses will run in the order drawn. Contestants are responsible for double checking the draw and making sure they are entered in the appropriate classes. After the class has started, entries are official according to the draw.
- ***Bridle Pro/Am—Open to both Non Pro and Open riders who have not won more than \$1500. NRCHA bit rules apply.
- *²Snaffle Bit & Derby Intermediate Open Divisions – All horses entered in the Intermediate Open division must enter the Open division. For those entered in ONLY the Open, All of their jackpot portion of the entry fee will stay in the Open division; For those horses entered in both the Open and Intermediate Open, their jackpot portion of the entry fee would be split 2/3 to the Open and 1/3 to the Intermediate.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND RELEASE

I, the undersigned, wishing to personally participate (or to have my minor child) participate in this equine event produced by the MVRCHA and in further consideration of the mutual covenants given by other participants, voluntarily give this Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability and Release. I understand that being around horses and cattle carries certain inherent dangers-both known and unforeseeable-and that in order for myself (and/or my minor child) to participate in this event, I must expose the participant to the dangers of actions and events precipitated by horses, people and cattle. I understand that sometimes there is reasonable action or inaction to be undertaken to avoid those risks of injury to persons or animals. Therefore, I willingly assume those risks of injury to myself (or my minor child) and to my property. I waive, release, and in advance, forgo my right to pursue any such claims, causes of action or right to pursue civil damages against the MVRCHA, its agents, volunteers, members, employees, and/or cattle contractors whether for personal injury or for property damage including those alleged to have arisen out of negligent and/or grossly negligent act or omission. Further, I agree to indemnify and to hold harmless the MVRCHA, its agents, volunteers, members, and/or employees from any cost arising out of injury to myself (or my minor child), or to my property.
